



Melbourne Indigenous Transition School (MITS) Boarding House - 371 Church Street

The MITS Boarding House project located at 371 Church Street in Richmond involves the demolition of an existing building (circa 1920 and 1980) and the construction of a new two-level administration and boarding house including one level of basement for the Melbourne Indigenous Transition School (MITS).

Kane has a strong partnership with MITS that continues to strengthen. Following the successful completion of the [MITS Boarding House Refurbishment at 139 Richmond Terrace](#), and most recently the [MITS Boarding House Refurbishment at 364 Church Street](#), Kane is delivering the new build at 371 Church Street at cost.

MITS is a residential transition school for young Indigenous students from remote and regional communities who aspire to get a great education away from home. Each year their school and boarding program delivers a Year 7 program to 22 students, who from Year 8 onwards transition to Melbourne partner schools across independent, government and catholic sectors.
