







NSW Health Infrastructure

In 2015, Kane Constructions was awarded the Early Contractor Involvement (ECI) contract to design and construct multiple NSW Paramedic Response Centres to facilitate the improved delivery of paramedic services.

Following a successful ECI period, Kane was then appointed in 2016 the design and construct contract to deliver six new centres consisting of a standard design tailored to site-specific conditions, accommodating paramedic response units ranging from 10 to 20 vehicles under one roof.

The buildings typically consist of a suitable hardstand area, steel-framed building structure, nominated façade cladding and dedicated office space.

Conceived to better align NSW paramedics and vehicles to meet patient activity and demand, the superstations are designed to ensure treatment is received for patients at the right time, in the right way, in a space specifically designed for movement efficiency and user practicality.

The following ambulance centres were delivered, improving the delivery of ambulance services:

- Paramedic Response Centre Artarmon
- Paramedic Response Centre Kogarah
- Paramedic Response Centre Caringbah
- Paramedic Response Centre Haberfield
- Paramedic Response Centre Randwick
- Paramedic Response Centre Mona Vale

Kane has delivered all six new ambulance stations and all facilities are open and operational.
